There may be times when volunteers are subjected to high stress situations which may be related to mental health or substance abuse disorders. A volunteer must be able to remain calm and ensure proper procedures are followed. 5. Training may be provided upon hire for Trauma Informed Care, Mental Health First Aid, and Medical CPR/First Aid. 6. All volunteers must consent to drug screens upon hire, annual, and random. 7. All volunteers must consent to undergo a criminal background check which may include finger printing. 8. Restrictions: 9. A current State of Michigan Foster Parent. 10. An employee of the Chippewa County Family Project Group Home. 11. In the process of adopting a children from without the Chippewa Country Family Project Group Home. 12. Anyone involved in a child dependency court matter.
